1. Head **north** on **Rosemead Blvd** toward **Valley Blvd** go 105 ft
total 105 ft
2. Make a U-turn at **Valley Blvd** go 0.7 mi
About 3 mins total 0.7 mi
3. Take the ramp onto **I-10 E** go 4.4 mi
About 5 mins total 5.0 mi
4. Take exit **31B** to merge onto **I-605 N** go 5.4 mi
About 6 mins total 10.4 mi
5. Take exit **27A** to merge onto **I-210 E/Foothill Fwy W** toward **Foothill Fwy/San Bernardino** go 3.4 mi
About 4 mins total 13.8 mi
6. Take exit **40** for **Azusa Ave/CA-39** go 0.3 mi
total 14.0 mi
7. Turn left onto **S Azusa Ave** go 1.8 mi
About 5 mins total 15.8 mi
8. Slight left onto **CA-39 N/N San Gabriel Canyon Rd** go 10.0 mi
About 15 mins total 25.9 mi
9. Turn right onto **E Fork Rd** go 5.2 mi
About 13 mins total 31.1 mi
10. Turn left onto **Camp Bonta Prairie Forks Rd** go 0.8 mi
About 2 mins total 31.9 mi
